

Global UX for Location Disambiguation

Universal Location Disambiguation Rule, applies to all domains:

If user selected a choice from list of options, we will remember this city and bump this city to top of list for future disambiguations

The priority methods do not have to be used in sequential order. Combination and sequence varies based on case by case scenarios. numberings 1 2 3 are recommendations only.

	Different time zone from user location	Closer to user's location will be prioritized	Higher population will be prioritized
Weather "What's the weather like in Memphis?" Memphis, Tennessee vs. Memphis, Egypt		1 if proximity is within 300 miles, we use proximity to disambiguate	2 if proximity is beyond 300 miles driving, we use population/popularity to disambiguate
Clock "What's the time in London?" London, UK vs. London, Ontario, Canada	2 if city asked for is beyond 20 miles, we use city with different time zone	1 if city asked is within 20 miles, we assume it's closer city	3
Sports "What's the score of Seattle?"		1
